

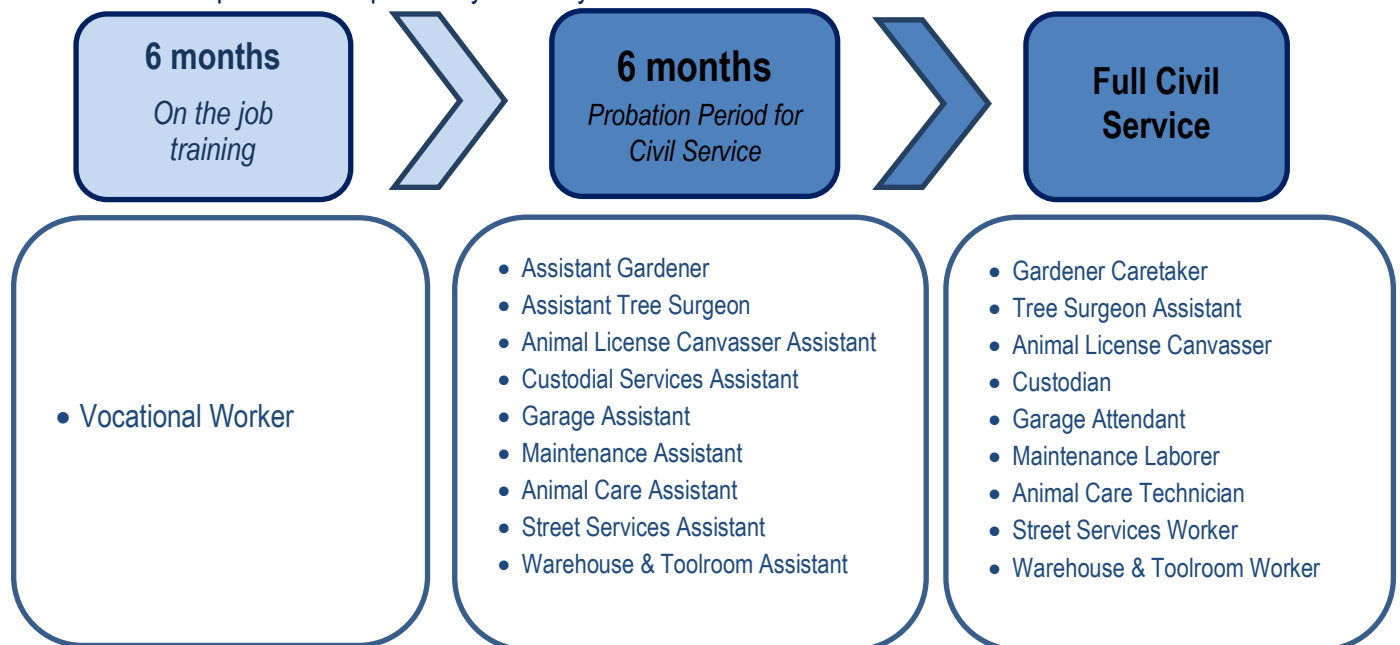
Vocational Workers receive on the job training that can eventually lead to a Civil Service career with the City of Los Angeles.

As a Vocational Worker, you can expect:

- ✓ **Full-time employment**
 - ✓ **At least \$15.00 an hour**
 - ✓ **Benefits (health, commute, and retirement savings)**
 - ✓ **On the job training & development**

As a Vocational Worker, you will receive six months of on-the-job training. During this time, you are exempt from Civil Service. Once you successfully complete the six month on-the-job training, which is considered your Civil Service examination, you will then be transitioned to a Civil Service classification. Note that you will still need to complete a six month probationary period before becoming a regular, Civil Service employee.

There are multiple career pathways that you can choose that all stem from Vocational Worker.

VOCATIONAL WORKER → ASSISTANT GARDENER → GARDENER CARETAKER

A Gardener Caretaker performs gardening, landscape construction, and maintenance work in parks, playgrounds, Citywide traffic islands, medians, slopes, grade separations and other landscaped areas.

It should be noted that as a Gardener Caretaker, you may be required to work weekends and holidays and can be reassigned to work any location in the City. You may also be required to work overtime and in bad weather.

ASSISTANT TREE SURGEON → TREE SURGEON ASSISTANT

An Assistant Tree Surgeon assists in tree trimming and removal work and performs a variety of unskilled tasks on the ground.

CUSTODIAL SERVICES ASSISTANT → CUSTODIAN

A Custodian performs a variety of cleaning and janitorial tasks in City buildings including keeping police, medical clinic and laboratory facilities in a clean and sanitary condition.

GARAGE ASSISTANT → GARAGE ATTENDANT

A Garage Attendant performs general servicing and lubricating of cars, trucks and motorcycles; chauffeuring; parking cars; washing and waxing; making minor repairs to vehicles; assists equipment mechanics by removing and replacing defective radiators, hoses, fan belts, and batteries; replaces tires on cars and trucks in the shop and in the field; may operate a light to heavy duty tow truck; and other tasks.

MAINTENANCE ASSISTANT → MAINTENANCE LABORER

A Maintenance Laborer performs a variety of manual work for the City of Los Angeles.

An Animal Care Technician receives and cares for all types of domestic and wild animals partners, local veterinarians/clinics, internal staff and staff in other departments and provi

ANIMAL LICENSE CANVASSER ASSISTANT → ANIMAL LICENSE CANVASSER

An Animal License Canvasser performs door-to-door inquiring for current dog & horse licenses, collecting license fee payments, verifying current rabies vaccinations and sterilization of dogs, reconciles and balances daily collections

STREET SERVICES ASSISTANT → STREET SERVICES WORKER

A Street Services Worker rakes hot mix asphalt; may shovel or spread hot asphalt materials to meet grade of existing structures in preparation for breakdown and intermediate rolling operations; operates screed controls of asphalt paving machine or may be assigned to slurry crew; makes small asphalt repairs to roadway; may maintain paperwork; assists equipment operator to hand load debris; cleans job-site; places warning devices for traffic control set-up and may be assigned to other duties related to various street repair operations.

WAREHOUSE & TOOLROOM ASSISTANT → WAREHOUSE & TOOLROOM WORKER

DRIVER

A Warehouse and Toolroom Worker performs manual and clerical work in ordering, receiving, storing, issuing, and accounting for materials, supplies, automotive parts, tools, and equipment; may be required to lift boxes, load and unload trucks, package materials and make supply deliveries; may operate motor-driven and various material handling and lifting equipment, including forklifts, jacks, and hoists. May perform minor repair, maintenance, and assembly on tools, equipment and materials; and does related work.

Competencies you will be expected to develop:

WHO CAN APPLY?

Everyone and anyone who meets the requirements for Vocational Worker may apply!

The Targeted Local Hire Program welcomes and strongly encourages the following communities to apply: homeless & formerly homeless; formerly incarcerated individuals; former gang, including those affected by the City's Rodriguez settlement; disconnected youth, foster youth, and transition age youth; veterans; local residents in zip codes with high unemployment and incomes below median poverty rate; disabled; transgender; older workers.

COVID-19 Vaccine Requirement:

In accordance with Los Angeles City Ordinance 187134, candidates must meet the minimum requirement of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 or receive an exemption and report their vaccination status prior to being hired by the hiring City department.
